## **Just Feel Better!**

#### The MR7<sup>TM</sup>Wellness Device

TheMR7, is a seven channel, milligauss, magnetic field stimulator that generates seven specific frequency patterns as magnetic fields at one time. The MR7 is Programmable, Light-weight, Pocket-size and has a rechargeable Lithium ion Battery. The MR7 Wellness device is considered to bea Non-significant risk device, by FDA standards.

#### MR7<sup>TM</sup> Operation



To turn on the MR7<sup>TM</sup>, press the ON button. U, located on the front panel. When the MR7 is operational, the GREEN RUN LED is on. The MR7 has an internal lithium ion rechargeable battery. If the internal lithium ion battery is low, a RED LED light goes on. To turn the MR7 off, press the ON button for 2 seconds and the GREEN RUN LED will turn off.

#### MR7<sup>TM</sup> Milligauss Seven Channel Magnetic Field



The milligauss, seven channel magnetic fields are located within the MR7 stimulator and attached to the back panel. To apply the magnetic fields to the body, the backside of the MR7 (opposite side of the power button)must be directed towards the body. The magnetic fields projecting from the backside of the MR7may be placed over fabric or materials that are non-magnetic, such as a shirt pocket or a pouch.

Although the frequency-specific magnetic fields generated by the MR7 affect the whole body, the recommendation is to place the magnetic disc close to the area to be treated.

#### MR7<sup>TM</sup> External Connections



There is one Mini USB port on the side of the MR7. The Mini USB is connected to a standard USB 2.0 Cable with a Type-A Male USB Connector and a Mini Type-B Male USB Connector at the other end. The USB cable is used to recharge the lithium ion battery and program the MR7. When you plug in the MR7 to charge, it will automatically turn off. We suggest charging 1 hour per day to run 24 hours. You can also recharge the MR7 with an AC charger that has a Mini USB end.


We suggest you wear your MR7, 23 hours a day, 7 days a week for maximum benefit. It is very important to sleep with your MR7.

#### Preparing for Treatment

You will need to drink 60 ounces of purified water each day for the frequency treatment to work. The MR7 is not waterproof or shockproof. Protect it as you would a small computer. **It will** 

cost you \$880 if you break it. Medicare, Medicaid or Health Insurance will not pay for use or loss of the MR7.





To connect the MR7 to the computer, take the supplied USB cable and orient the smaller end so that the side with the black rectangle is on top.



Make sure the MR7 is OFF and plug the USB cable into the MR7. The MR7 is OFF if the green LED (by the MR7 label) is not lit.




Plug the larger end of the USB cable into your computer.



To run the MR7 software, double-click the Pulsed Frequency MR7 shortcut on the desktop.

## **Run the Software for the First Time**


When you first run the software, it will check to see if file bank and software updates are available. This will also happen any other time you run the software.




During this process, a small dialog box will display. If no updates are available, the dialog will just go away.

If updates are available, the above dialog box will appear. If you click **Update on Exit**, this box will disappear and you will be back at the main menu page. The software will then be updated when you click the **Close Program** button. If you click **Update Now**, the software will be updated immediately. If you click **Cancel**, no update will be performed.




If you clicked **Update Now**, a progress bar will be displayed as the software and file banks are being downloaded.

There are several categories of treatment programs available in the Compiler. Here are the major categories that always appear at the top of the **Categories** list.

- A-Z All Files an alphabetical listing of all treatment files in all categories.
- A-Z Combined a list of compiled treatment programs that you have created.
- **Commonly Used Compiled Files** a list of predefined treatment programs supplied with the software that are for specific purposes.

Treatment programs can be created in two ways. You can create your own treatment program or select a predefined program.

To select a predefined program, under **Categories**, click the **Commonly Used Compiled Files** category. Next, under **Frequency Files**, click one of the predefined programs, then click the **Add** button. When you do this, the files in that treatment program will be loaded into the spreadsheet on the right.

To create your own treatment program, just select a treatment file from one of the categories and click **Add**. Repeat this process until you are finished. The software will allow up to 999 minutes of total programming.

In the example above, we selected Concussion Est 210, then clicked Add.

After you have selected the treatment programs, you must enter the **Number of Repeats**. If you want the set of programs to run one time only, enter a 0 for the **Number of Repeats**. If you enter 2 for the repeats, the set of programs will run once, then repeat two more times, for a total of 3 times. You may enter a number of repeats from 0 to 255.

When you are ready, click the **Transfer Treatment to Device** button and the Name Bank list will be displayed. Every time a treatment is transferred to the MR7, you will need to select a person's name under which to file it. The treatment will then be saved to that person's treatment file history in the Treatment Files function that is accessed from the main menu page.

If you do not see the Name Bank list, the following message will probably be displayed. This means you have a connection problem.



When this happens, go to the **Troubleshooting** section of the manual.



Here are all the functions available from the main menu page.

- **View Frequency Files in Device** This allows you to view the frequency files currently loaded into the MR7.
- **Magnetic Frequency File Bank** This allows you to view the frequencies in any frequency file in the frequency file bank.
- **Compiler** This allows you to build treatment programs and transfer them into the MR7.
- Create Magnetic Frequency File This allows you to create a frequency file from scratch and save it.
- Edit Magnetic Frequency File This allows you to edit an existing frequency file and save it.
- **Treatment Files** This allows you to view a history of treatments that have been loaded onto the MR7 in the past. You can select any one of them and load it again into your device. You can also print any part of the treatment history you wish or save it to a text file.
- Check for Updates This checks to see if software and file bank updates are available.

#### Pulsed Frequency

• **File Storage** - This allows you to indicate where to save your treatment files. It can also show you the serial number of your JOINT PEMF device, and allow you to choose what type of device detection method to use.



When you click the **Treatment Files** button on the main menu page, you are transferred to that screen, and the treatment files will be displayed from the location that you have specified on this tab.

If you selected Local Machine, then the treatment files on the computer will be displayed.

If you selected **Cloud**, then the treatment files on the cloud will be displayed.

If you selected **Combined**, then the treatment files on both the Local Machine and Cloud will be displayed. In most cases, the Local Machine and Cloud treatment files will be the same. However, if you like to switch back and forth between Local Machine and Cloud, this setting is useful as it will display a combined list of the two.

The **Detect Method** tab allows you to select the method of device detection. When the software is first installed, **Auto-Detect** is selected by default. This means that your **MR7** will be detected automatically when you connect it to the computer. In most cases, the software will work fine if you leave this setting alone.

In a very small percentage of cases, the **Manual Detect** setting may work better. This is usually only needed on older computers that are slower. The only way to tell if you need to switch to **Manual Detect** is if your **MR7** has continuous problems being detected when Auto-Detect is selected.

To use Manual Detect, select the setting, click **Save Changes**, then click the **Close** button. On the main menu page, click **Close Program** to exit from the software.

To learn how to do manual detection, please go to the section of the manual entitled, **MR7 Manual Detection**.

The **Backup** / **Restore** tab has functions which allow you to back up and restore your Pulsed Frequency software.

The **Backup** function will back up all the Pulsed Frequency software installed on your computer to a flash drive or external hard drive. This includes file banks, files you have created and your settings.

The **Restore** function restores all file banks, files you have created and settings from a flash drive or external hard drive to all the Pulsed Frequency software installed on your computer.



The Pulsed Frequency software on your computer is listed on the left. The external drives are listed on the right. Select an external drive from the list on the right, then click the **Backup** button.




While the function is backing up all your software to the external drive, you will see messages displayed like the one above that show you what version is currently being backed up. When the process has finished, you will be returned to the **Backup / Restore** page.



When you click **Restore**, the following dialog box will appear.




The list of external drives connected to your computer will be on the left. Select one.



After you have selected an external drive, the list of software backed up on that drive will appear on the right. When you click Restore, the program will restore the files to only the software you have installed on the computer.

For example, let's say you want to back up your desktop computer and restore onto a laptop. You have all 11 versions of Pulsed Frequency software on the desktop computer and when you backed up to the external drive, all 11 versions were backed up. But, the laptop you want to restore to only has 4 versions of Pulsed Frequency software. That is fine. The program will only restore the files to the versions of software you have on the laptop computer.

If you are a practitioner and have a clinic with multiple rooms each having computers with Pulsed Frequency software installed, you should backup from the computer that has the most editions of the software installed. When you take the external drive to each of the other rooms, you will be assured that all the software on the computers in those rooms will be restored.



After you press the **Restore** button, the program will let you know what Pulsed Frequency software is currently being restored.

### Troubleshooting

If you have problems detecting your MR7 device, you will need to troubleshoot the problem. To do this, exit from the software and try the following solutions.

#### **Solution 1**

The MR7 must be turned off before you connect it to the computer. It does not matter if the software is running or not when you connect the device. The key is that the MR7 must be turned off when you connect the USB cable to it.

#### Solution 2

Even though you have the USB cable plugged into the MR7 and to the computer, you may not have a good connection. Unplug the cable from both the MR7 and the computer, then plug the cable back into both places. Next, run the software, click View Frequency Files in Device, and see if the words, "MR7 is not connected" still appear on the screen. If they don't, your problem is solved. You can now proceed to the Software User Guide section. If you still see the words, proceed to Solution 2.

#### Solution 3

The most common cause of a connection problem is that Windows cannot see your device. Try plugging the USB cable into a different USB port on your computer. Also, unplug the cable from your MR7 and plug it back in. Run the software again, click View Frequency Files in Device and see if you can see the files loaded into your MR7. If you can see the files, proceed to the Software User Guide section. If you still get the message, "MR7 is not connected", proceed to Solution 3.

### **Solution 4**

Sometimes, the MR7 can be in an error state, and no amount of plugging and unplugging cables will solve the problem. To test if your device is in an error state, press the power button momentarily, and then immediately let it up. If you hear a beep, the device was in an error state, and you just cleared the error. Run the software again and try to load a treatment onto the MR7. If you are able to, your problem is solved.

### Solution 5


If you are still having a problem, try plugging the larger end of the USB cable into a USB hub. The hub must be powered for this to work. A powered USB hub is where a power cable runs from the hub to an AC adapter that plugs into a wall outlet. With the MR7 plugged into the hub, run the software and try to load a treatment. If you can, your problem is solved.

### Solution 6

Another cause of a connection problem is a bad USB cable. If you suspect your cable, then replace it and try again.

#### **Solution 7**

If all other solutions have failed, a final check is to run the Device Manager.




If you are using Windows 10, go to the lower left hand corner of the screen and enter the words "device manager". When that choice appears in the list, click on it.

If you are using Windows 8 or 8.1, click the flag in the lower left hand corner and type "device manager." When that choice appears in the list, click on it.

If you are on Windows 7, click the Start button in the lower left hand corner, and enter "device manger" in the search box. When that choice appears in the list, click on it.



In Device Manager, click the arrow next to Ports (COM & LPT) in order to expand the list. If the MR7 is connected and you see something similar to the screenshot above, then Windows cannot see your device. Try any of the above solutions then come back to Device Manager and look at the list.



When Windows can see your MR7, you will see an entry similar to the one above that says, "USB Serial Port (COM3). It may show a different COM port, but that is okay. The main thing to remember is that when Windows can see your MR7, it will assign a COM port to it. You should now be able to run the software and transfer treatments to the MR7.

### **MR7** Manual Detection

Please follow these steps in order to manually detect your MR7.

On Windows 10, click the Windows flag in the lower left corner of the screen and scroll down the list of programs until you see the Pulsed Frequency folder. Expand that folder and select **Detect MR7**.

On Windows 8 or 8.1, click the Windows flag in the lower left corner of the screen, type "detect mr7" and when that item is displayed in the list on the right, select it to run the utility.

On Windows 7, go to the Start Menu, click All Programs, scroll down to the Pulsed Frequency folder and select the **Detect MR7** program. Make sure your MR7 is not connected to the computer when you do this.

After you have clicked on the shortcut, you will get a warning from Windows saying "Do you want to allow this app from an unknown publisher to make changes to your device?" Click "Yes". Follow the instructions on the screen to detect your device.





When your device has been detected, you will be returned to the main screen of the program.



The location of the MR7 will be displayed on this screen and its location will have been saved in the configuration information for the Pulsed Frequency MR7 software. You can now click the **Close Program** button to exit the utility. This completes the manual detection process.

The Pulsed Frequency<sup>TM</sup> software can now be run with the MR7. Go to the desktop and doubleclick on the MR7 shortcut.
